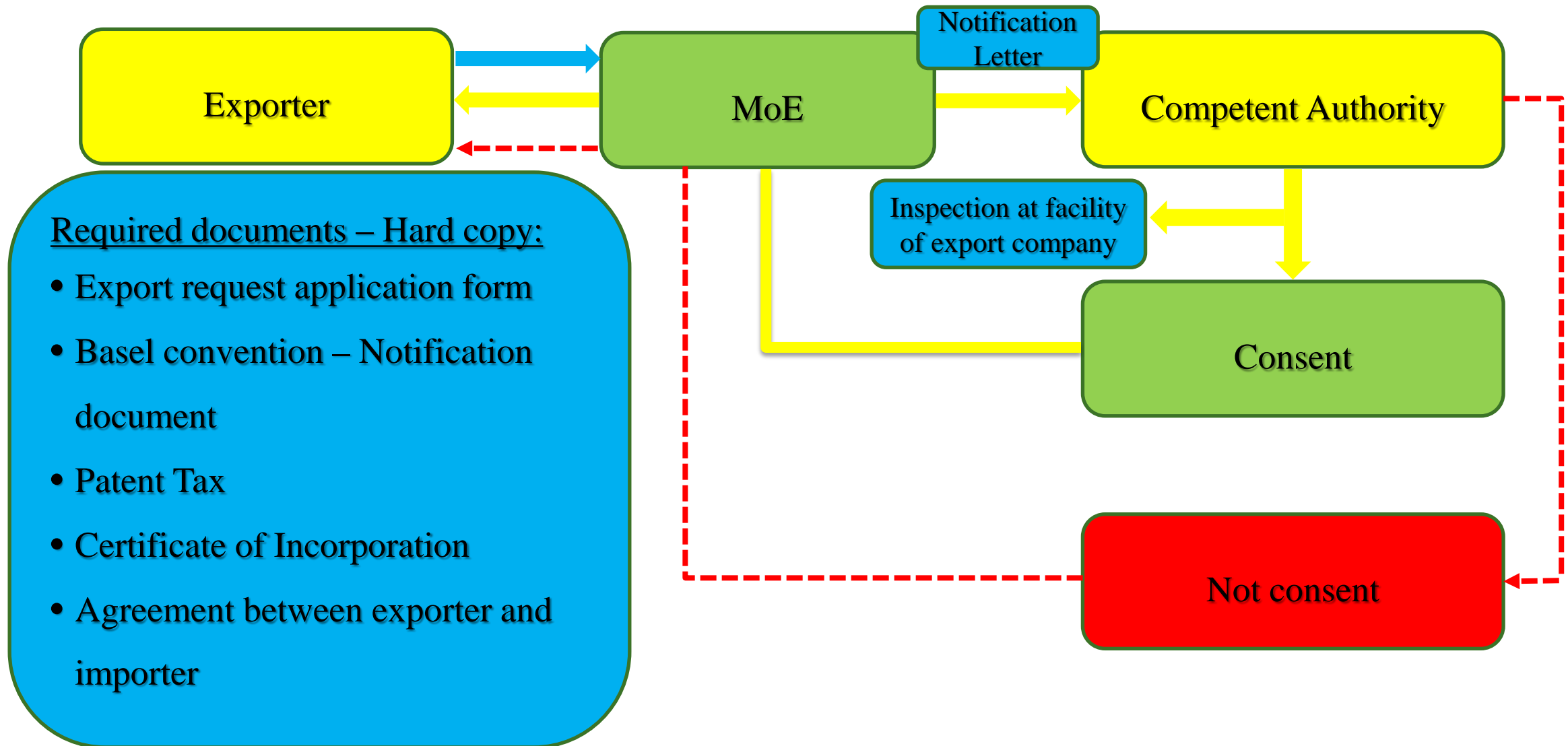

Good Practices for the Implementation of PIC (Cont.)

General Department of Customs and Excise developed online system for applying for a permit for import and export called “National Single Window”.

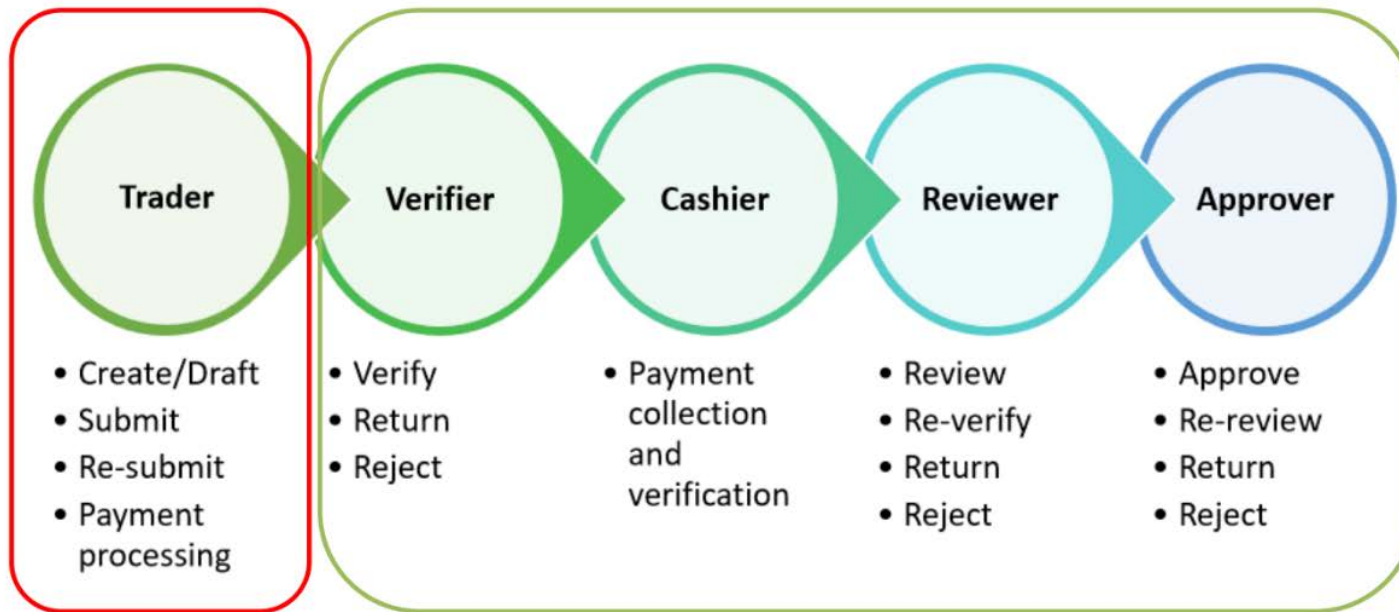


- Permit for import and export under the Ministry of Environment is integrated in Phase 3.
- The system will be put in place in 2024.

Good Practices for the Implementation of PIC (Cont.)

Permits for import and export under MoE which integrated in NSW are:

- The export of hazardous wastes.
- The import of used electrical and electronic equipment.



Step of reviewer, MoE will send notification letter to competent authority.

Challenges of Implementation of PIC

- It takes time to get response from competent authority of importing country.
- It takes time to get a permit for approval.
