What is KCNC?

- **Keidanren** (Japan Business Federation)
- **KCNC** (Keidanren Committee on Nature Conservation)
- Established in **1992** (the Earth Summit in Rio, Brazil)



Three Main Functions

- **Supporting** NGO for their nature conservation activities through KNCF
- **Promoting** collaborations between companies and NGOs
- **Developing** awareness on nature conservation and biodiversity

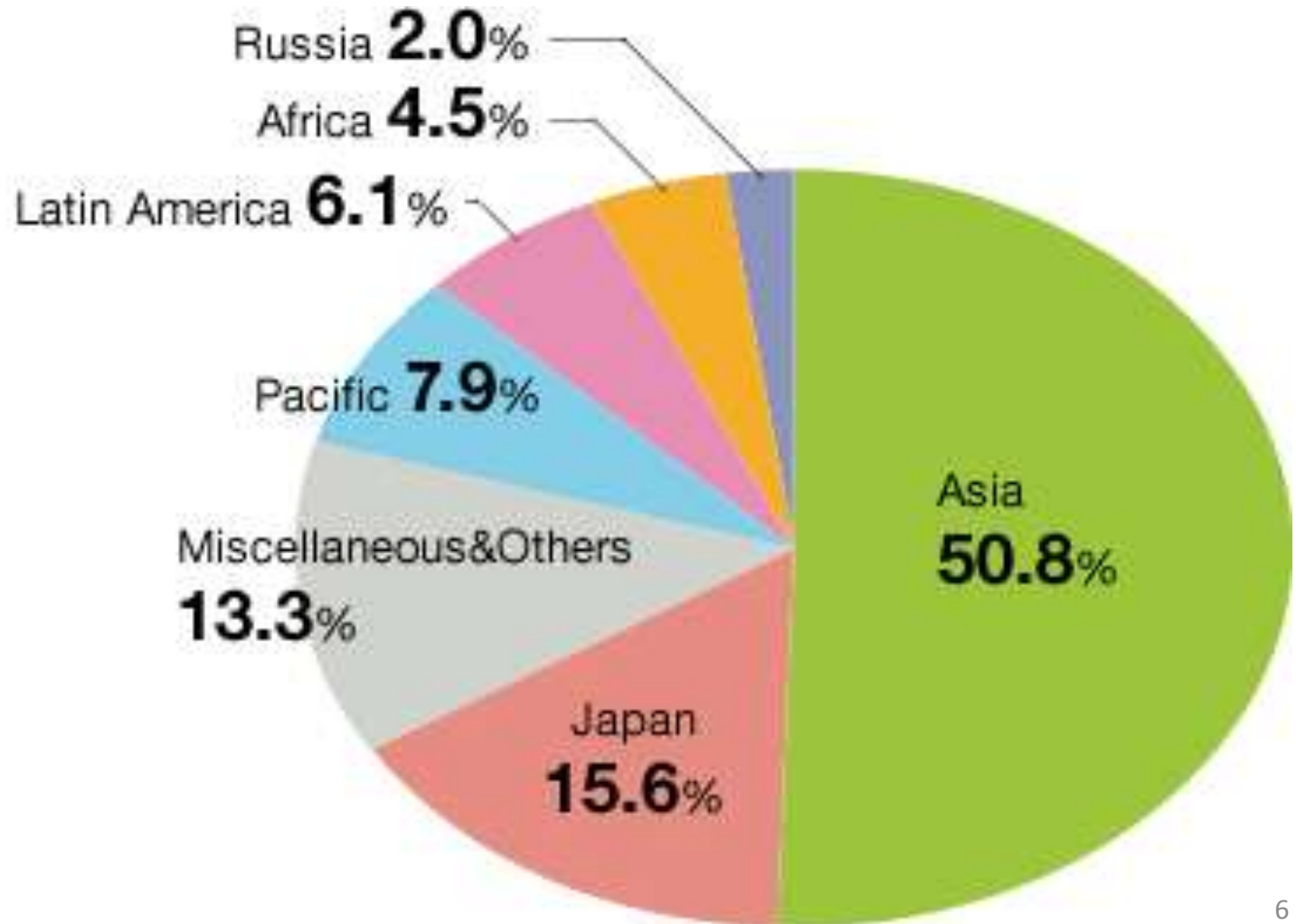
Supporting

- Fund NGO for their nature conservation activities through **KNCF** (Keidanren Nature Conservation Fund)
- over **20** years
- about **1,100** projects
- approximately US\$ **32** million



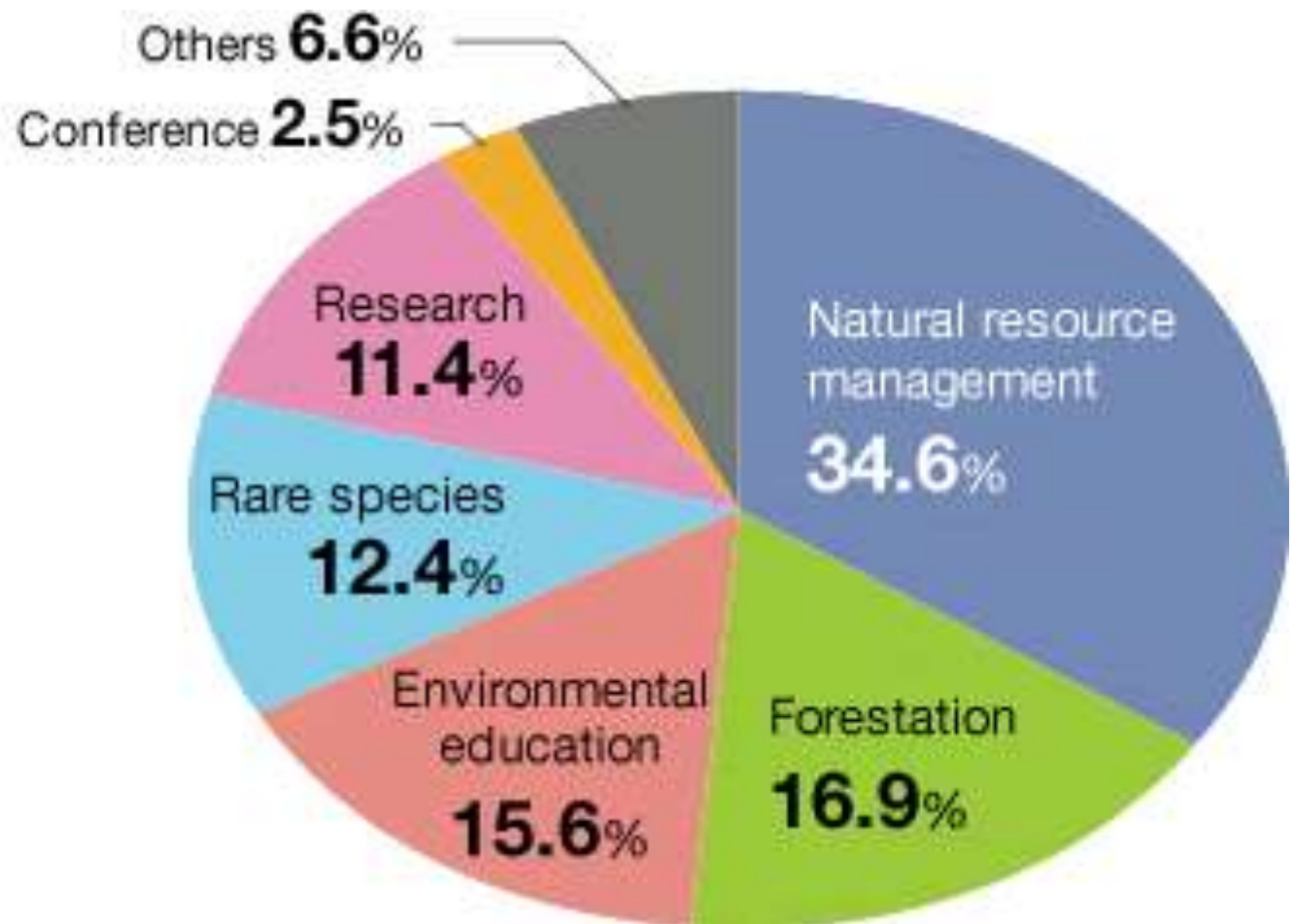
