- Providing opportunities to acquire the knowledge, values, attitudes, commitment, and skills;
- Create new patterns of behavior as a whole towards the environment.

Categories of Objectives

- 1. Gain Awareness & sensitivity
- 2. Knowledge and understanding
- 3. Acquire a set of Attitudes (values, feelings and motivation)
- 4. Acquire Skills for identifying & solving problem.
- 5. Provide an opportunity to be actively involved at all levels (Participation)
