Hosting objectives:

- Implement ICRI's "Continuing Call to Action" and "Framework for Action 2013" in compliance with the
 "Organisation and Management Procedures"
- Organize two General Meetings:
 - ♦ GM 29: Oct. 20-23, 2014 Naha, Japan (TBC)
- The 3 themes will be
 - Engaging other sectors: While climate change and ocean acidification are impacting coral reef ecosystems
 globally, minimizing other anthropogenic pressures would increase the ecological resilience on a local scale. Under
 this theme, we discuss the necessity and ways to engage other sectors to address these anthropogenic pressures.
 - Reef zoning for multiple use: Many countries have problems in planning for and implementing sustainable
 exploitation of reef resources. Under this theme, we discuss the potential of reef zoning for multiple use (e.g., tourism,
 fisheries, biodiversity conservation, etc.) and ways to introduce it.
 - 3. Revisiting ICRI's place among multilateral environmental agreements, other international bodies and initiatives: ICRI is a voluntary initiative which will mark its 20th anniversary during this hosting period. In the last 20 years, many other initiatives have come into existence. Under this theme, we discuss ICRI's place in the international conservation community.
