
Trek the fantastical moss-covered forest and gorge in Okuchichibu

Trek through fantastical moss-covered forest and gorge and climb the peak of Mt. Kobushigatake, nicknamed the "navel" of Okuchichibu, where breathtaking panoramic views unfold. Starting from the trailhead at Nishizawa Gorge, head through a lush and verdant forest to the source of the Arakawa River. Enjoy rafting as well in the scenic beauty of the deep gorge created by the river that is part of the daily lives of residents of the Kanto and Chubu areas.
