Harshness and blessing of nature felt through fascinating marine landscape and dynamic and elegant rocks

The Ashizuri area is home to coral and subtropical fish and the colorful scenery unfurls beneath the water despite the high latitude due to a dynamic and elegant coastline created by major tectonic movement and the Kuroshio, the world's largest warm current. Tatsukushi National Marine Park offers diving, glass-bottom boat rides, and snorkeling. Meet the astonishingly beautiful underwater scenery including a cluster of shikorosango coral. Stroll the landscape formed over the years by earthquakes, tsunami, rain, and wind to witness the power of nature. At the Ashizuri Aquarium SATOUMI, learn about the local ecosystem of local creatures while tracing the journey of rainfall on the mountain to the ocean via satoyama (mountainous areas where people utilize forest resources)
