Located in the southernmost tip of Japan, the park offers Japan's largest mangrove forest, coral reefs, and many other landscapes unique to the subtropical zone. The park is perfect for marine and other outdoor activities to fully enjoy nature such as kayaking, snorkelling, scuba diving, and trekking. A twillight tour is also available. Don't miss the starry sky of the island, which was recognized as Japan's first International Dark Sky Place. The great nature of the island is part of the tradition and culture of the island. Enjoy the sounds of a three-stringed instrument called the sanshin and traditional folk music passed down to the present since the time when the Ryukyu Kingdom ruled. Immerse yourself in nature and experience ancient customs and appreciate the awe-inspiring nature in ancient times.
