- Protection plan
- Special protection zone: It constitutes the core zone of the park, and retains superb natural landscapes in a primitive state. Human activities are strictly restricted.
 - Class I special area: It has landscapes equivalent to a special protection zone. Among special areas, the need to maintain the scenic beauty is the highest. It is necessary to protect the current landscape as much as possible.
 - Class II special area: There is a high need to coordinate agriculture, forestry, and fisheries activities and maintain good scenic beauty.
 - Class III special area: In principle, ordinary agriculture, forestry, and fisheries activities are less likely to affect efforts to maintain the scenic beauty.
 - Ordinary area: It protects landscape as a buffer zone between a special area and zones outside the park boundary.
