FY2006 and FY2007 Status of Industrial Waste Treatment Facilities and Licensed Business Operators

On November 4, 2010 the Ministry of the Environment compiled and announced the FY2006 and FY2007 survey on the status of industrial waste treatment facilities, licensed business operators, waste collection by cross-jurisdictional waste treatment contractors, and disposal capacity of final landfill sites. This survey aimed to obtain basic data for the promotion of policies concerning industrial waste management.
