## Invitation

Measurement is a key element for odor management. In 1995, Japan introduced an olfactory method, which is called the "Triangular Odor Bag Method" to the Offensive Odor Control Law. In Europe, CEN (Committee European de Normalisation) has adopted the "European Standard on Air Quality-Determination of Odour Concentration by Dynamic Olfactmetry", while, in the USA, A&WMA (Air & Waste Management Association) has finalized its "Guidelines for Odor Sampling and Measurement by Dynamic Dilution Olfactometry".

It is high time for experts from leading countries in the world to exchange information and views on odor measurement issues such as the comparability of data between different methods, quality assurance/quality control and the function of measurement in the legal framework.

The Ministry of the Environment of Japan will be hosting the International Workshop on Odor Measurement on June 23 and 24, 2003, in Beppu City, Japan. Invited experts from Asia-Pacific region, Europe and North America will make presentation at the workshop. We hope this workshop could promote mutual understanding of experts from major countries, and help future work in order to set up possible international standardization on odor measurement.


## Venue
