

Background of Proposed Establishment of Regional 3R Forum in Asia

- Increasing Waste generation with urbanization and industrialization are a pressing common issue for all Asian countries. 3R concept disseminated.
- Recognition of co-benefits of 3R in addressing resource efficiency and energy efficiency(climate change).
- Policy dialogues, developing national strategies (Bangladesh, Cambodia, Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam), knowledge management efforts, etc. in progress.
- Need for <u>prioritizing 3R and waste management policies</u>
- Need for <u>action-oriented</u> efforts, materializing projects
- Need for seeking <u>synergy among initiatives</u>, and <u>involving various</u> <u>stakeholders</u>



Establishment of 'Regional 3R Forum in Asia', a new open platform for regional cooperation is proposed.

Goal of Regional 3R Forum in Asia

- Achieve "low carbon and sound material cycle societies in Asia" through:
- Facilitating bilateral and multilateral cooperation for:
 - increasing resource and energy efficiency through the 3Rs
 - promoting environmentally sound management of wastes in the region

Objectives / Roles of Regional Forum

- (i) **facilitate high-level policy dialogues** on 3R issues, challenges, and opportunities;
- (ii)facilitate improved dialogue and cooperation with international organizations and donor communities for materializing and implementation of projects and programmes related to 3R and waste management identified through national 3R strategies;
- (iii) provide a strategic and knowledge platform for sharing experiences & disseminating among Asian countries best practices, tools, technologies, and policy instruments;
- (iv) provide a platform to develop multilayered networks of stakeholders such as governments, academia, and private sectors, and NGOs;
- (v) generate international consensus on the beneficial aspects of 3R in the context of achieving MDG, resource and energy efficiency, resource efficient economy, and climate change mitigation; and to
- (vi) provide platform for proliferation of National 3R Strategies.


Asian Countries' Priorities for Strategic Implementation of the 3Rs

- ➤ Mainstreaming 3Rs in environmental and economic policies and programs
- ➤ Mobilizing **financial resources** for Implementation of 3Rs
- Development of human resources as well to facilitate efficient diffusion of 3R knowledge and technologies
- ➤ Understanding and implementation of co-benefits of the 3Rs (GHG reduction etc.)
- Development of necessary organizational framework/support to deal with the informal sector
- Development and transfer of environmentally sound technologies for waste management and the 3Rs
- Empowering cities to build them as core clients for financing and investments towards implementation of 3Rs / materializing Sustainable or Eco City.
- ➤ Information sharing and technical capacity development for prevention of inappropriate and illegal trade of waste
- ►International collaborative policy research on sustainable resource cycles in Asia


Initial set of activities and programs under the umbrella framework of the *Forum*

- Hold high-level policy dialogue on a regular basis
- Facilitate implementation, replication, and scaling up of 3Rrelated pilot projects and other good practices in close collaboration with donor agencies.
- Collaborate with the existing 3R information/research networks at national and international level
- Promote 3R business feasibility studies involving both public and private sector
- Conduct international collaborative, advanced policy relevant scientific research on sound material cycles in Asia on a continuous basis
- Capacity building through means such as international training programmes

Expected Outcomes

- International cooperation for better environmental governance of the region.
- Facilitation of business opportunities for the 3Rs in Asia

- Identification of necessary actions and steps for appropriate implementation of the environmentally sound management of waste and 3R.
- Capacity development of developing countries to implement the 3Rs
- Dissemination of 3R-related good practices around the region through demonstration projects

Establishment of Regional 3R Forum in Asia

- High-level policy dialogue to be held In Tokyo in the latter half of 2009
- A statement to be adopted to announce common intention of participating countries, international organizations and aid agencies for the promotion of the 3Rs in Asia
