## <International Collaborative Research (7-9)>

Conduct policy relevant research and survey on resource circulation policies of Asian countries in cooperation with research institutes and universities.

## <Information Sharing and Technical Capacity Development (7-8)>

### Cooperation through Waste Thematic Working Group under the Regional Forum on Environment and Health in Southeast and East Asian countries

Collect and share good practices and develop policy recommendations on municipal and medical waste management through multi-national dialogue.

### Support for 3R Knowledge Hub

Support a web-based information base operated by ADB, AIT, UNEP and UNESCAP to store and provide 3R related knowledge and technical information.

### Support for Society of Solid Waste Management Experts in Asia & Pacific Islands

A network of Asian researchers and experts in waste management in Asia & Pacific islands.

### Partnership on the Environmentally Sound Management of Electrical and Electronic Wastes in the Asia-Pacific Region
