- The significance of promoting sound material cycle and resource efficiency is widely recognized.
- Further development of 3R policy is essential.
- Special attention should be given to capacity development for the 3Rs and resource efficiency
- 3R policies maybe implemented in various forms, because of the differences in social, economic, and cultural situations of each country.
