

Issues and Challenges

Up Stream

- Majority of domestic wastewater is managed by on-site system
- Low awareness of hygiene and sanitation in communities
- · Low quality of sanitation facility
- · Low access to sanitation facility
- Limited land availability in slum urban area

Down Stream

- Polluted water sources
- Low effluent quality from onsite system
- High cost of investment, operational and maintenance for off-site system
- Non-functional existing sanitation facility
